Policy Proposal on Cannabis

Preamble

Whereas the Courtney and District Fish and Game Protective Association recognizes the use of Cannabis is now legal in Canada, this Association also recognizes the need to regulate the use of Cannabis and its derivatives on Association property, consistent with the needs of the Association, its Members, and Regulations for public use of Cannabis developed by the Province of British Columbia.

“Therefore, be it resolved that;

Members and/or their guests may smoke or vape Cannabis in those areas specifically designated for that purpose by the Board.

If this policy is adopted by the members at the General Meeting the regulations will be amended as follows:

General Property Regulations

8. No illegal drugs are to be brought onto club property.

9. The consumption of alcohol and the smoking or vaping of cannabis is not allowed in the swimming area or while walking around the property. Consumption of alcohol or smoking or vaping cannabis is allowed in designated areas only. Smoking and vaping of cannabis must be done at least 6 metres from doors or windows. The consumption of alcohol or cannabis at ANY shooting venue including the archery trail is strictly prohibited and in no case shall any member or guest be at any shooting venue while impaired by any substance. Please do not drive a vehicle or boat while impaired.

Campground Regulations

20. Alcohol and cannabis consumption is only allowed within designated areas. Do not carry open liquor between campsites. No alcohol or cannabis consumption by vaping or smoking is allowed on the beaches or any area outside the campground. Remember, second-hand smoke of any kind can be harmful and irritating to people, especially children, so be mindful and considerate when smoking or vaping any substance.
