

CF&G Shotgun Range COVID Safety Plan – November 23, 2020

It is the responsibility of all members to be aware of and follow the latest orders issued by the Public Health Officer of BC. Please do not attend the shotgun facility if you are feeling unwell, have tested positive for COVID 19 or have travelled outside the region in the last 14 days.

In response to the latest PHO Orders and to help maintain the health and safety of all participants, the following conditions shall apply:

- Social distancing (a minimum of 2m or 6 ft) shall be maintained at all times amongst all attendees, both indoors and outdoors.
- Masks must be worn by everyone entering the shotgun clubhouse as per the latest PHO: “Masks are now required for everyone in all public indoor settings and workplaces”.
- The facility will be open to members only on Thursdays and Sundays, from 10am until 1pm. A member may be accompanied by up to 2 guests, providing they are from the same family or household.
- Everyone must sign in at the door on arrival with name, member number and phone number (for possible contact tracing). By signing in you are stating that you are not feeling unwell and you will abide by the conditions set out in this document.
- The Shotgun Clubhouse will be open for the purposes of purchasing tokens, cards, ammunition and for use of the washrooms:
 - Maximum capacity inside the building is 15
 - Please enter through the patio door and leave through the washroom door to the outside
 - The kitchen will be closed for food service but prepackaged snacks, bottled water and soft drinks are available for purchase
 - Coffee may be served outside but you are encouraged to bring your own hot beverages
 - Eating and drinking are permitted only in the patio area
 - Please do not loiter or gather socially inside the building
- Limits for participants per squad in all disciplines shall be as follows:
 - 3 per squad for skeet rotating, all 3 wearing gloves
 - 5 shooters per squad for trap, using the voice-activated throwers
 - 5 shooters per squad for 5-stand, with 1 person in the control booth
 - 3 per squad for sporting clays rotating, all 3 wearing gloves
- Assemble your firearms at home or in your vehicle, not on the patio.
- Squadding for all disciplines will be done informally (no sign-up sheets).
- All scheduled tournaments and special events are canceled until further notice.
